



## Level 1 Objectives

**CEFR A1:** Can understand and use familiar everyday expressions and very basic phrases aimed at the satisfaction of needs of a concrete type. Can introduce him/herself and others and can ask and answer questions about personal details such as where he/she lives, people he/she knows and things he/she has. Can interact in a simple way provided the other person talks slowly and clearly and is prepared to help.

**Course Goal:** Students will develop basic conversational English for introductions, greetings, asking for and giving information, shopping and ordering in restaurants. Students will learn how to read and write simple passages. They will practice seven difficult English sounds and master English grammar at a basic beginner level.

### **Grammar Objectives: Students will demonstrate 70% mastery in:**

- **Verbs:** Present of *be*, simple present tense, present progressive tense, verbs with two objects, *there is/there are*, possessive forms
- **Nouns:** singular/plural, irregular plurals
- **Articles:** definite article, indefinite article
- **Pronouns:** subject, object, demonstrative, and interrogative (*what, how, who where*)
- **Adjectives:** possessive adjectives, adjectives as modifiers of nouns
- **Adverbs:** adverbs of manner
- **Sentence Types:** affirmative statements, *yes-no* questions, short answers, negative statements, and information questions
- **Numbers** 1 - 200

### **Reading Objectives: Students will demonstrate comprehension of:**

- Passage word length: 60-160 words per lesson
- Ten original fiction texts

### **Writing Objectives: Students will be able to write basic descriptive statements and three- sentence paragraphs about various topics:**

- A description of your family
- A paragraph about some tourists
- A description of a friend
- A narrative about family activities
- An email to a friend
- A paragraph about student's daily activities
- A description of a town
- A description of a party
