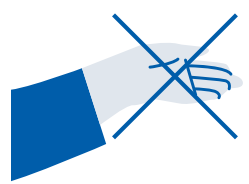


# How we are keeping our schools safe

Below you will find the steps that we are taking to keep all our LADO schools in The United States safe.

## School Safety: Common areas and classes.



Classes will have an average of 3-8 students to allow for social distancing.



Social distancing and hygiene will be reinforced.



Hand sanitizer available for all staff and students throughout the school.



Everyone must properly wear a face covering.



Access to student lounge is restricted to avoid gatherings.

## Prior to entering any LADO school, all students and staff must complete a Covid-19 Visitor Survey located in our website.



Increased frequency of cleaning.

Classrooms are set up to allow for social distancing.

Student activities (The English Club) will continue online.



## Minimize face to face contact



New student orientation will continue to be online. Any additional student support will be given through TEAMS.

Registration will continue to be online. The Michigan Test and Placement Test will continue to be online.

Students should bring their own laptops.
